- to build on the work of previous VWEC quarterly meetings, by drawing on the outcomes for VWEC (and for education in virtual worlds more generally) expressed by participants at those meetings, and using them to plan for the future

- to do this by using Theory of Change and asking VWEC participants to focus on one of the previously-expressed outcomes and give their ideas about what the current situation is, what the enablers are and what the activities should be to bring about the change that can achieve the outcome.

[2021/10/06 09:11] Sheila Yoshikawa: What is Theory of Change? (ToC)

[2021/10/06 09:12] Sheila Yoshikawa: ToC is a participatory approach to project evaluation, which has been used in formal education and in community projects. You start by identifying desired outcomes for the project, and its impact, then go back to map out the current situation and what needs to change, what is required to achieve the change, and the activities that have to happen to achieve the outcomes. After that you look at how you can evaluate whether the outcomes and impacts have been achieved.

[2021/10/06 09:14] Sheila Yoshikawa: 1. the current situation (What needs to change from the current situation? Who are the stakeholders and what is their contribution to/role in the desired outcome?)

2. "Enablers" - What help and support is needed to make sure the change happens?

3. "Activities/Processes" What needs to happen to achieve each the outcome? What does each stakeholder group need to do?

1. You will pick ONE Outcome that you want to work on. Note - this is a "project" outcome not a learning outcome. The 5 options are listed below.

You will do this by standing near the portal of the outcome you choose. Please wait a minute or two until everyone's made their choice before teleporting.
